FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

March 15, 2020

1. **Is the PA State USBC cancelling any of its events?**

No events are being cancelled at this time. However, events are postponed.

The following events are postponed with new event start dates:

- Open Championships – Postponed to May 1
- Women's Championships – Postponed to May 1
- Youth Open – Postponed to May 30
- District Pepsi/HDCP Tournaments – Postponed till May
- Pepsi/HDCP State Finals – Postponed to June 20-21

Dates and times for teams scheduled from May 1 and forward do not change.

The following events are currently still planned as scheduled:

- Mixed Tournament – June 13 – July 26
- Annual Meeting – July 10-12
- Women's Senior Tournament – July 25-26, August 1-2

2. **When will the postponed events take place?**

- Open Championships – May 1 to June 21
- Women's Championships – May 1 to June 14
- Youth Open – May 30 to June 14
- District Pepsi/HDCP Tournaments – Please see District schedule on web site
- Pepsi/HDCP State Finals – June 20-21

3. **What do I do as a team captain impacted by the starting date change?**

- Open Championships – Tournament Director will contact you
- Women's Championships – Tournament Director will contact you
- Youth Open – Tournament Director will contact you
- District Pepsi/HDCP Tournaments – District Tournament Directors will contact Youth League Supervisors with the new information.

4. **What if I want to cancel participating in an upcoming event?**

We encourage all participants to weigh their options and determine the best decision for them personally. We will reschedule your date to any available date or to the 2021 tournament.
