Fred Gutshall entered the Pennsylvania State USBC Hall of Fame for his dedicated service to the game of bowling.

Fred has served the Seven Mountains Bowling Association as its secretary for 48 consecutive years. He was instrumental in securing and working the State Championship Tournament hosted by his local association in 1966 and the State Seniors Tournament in 1978. Since the Seven Mountains association is celebrating its 50th year, Fred published a 50th Anniversary History book. He is the guiding force for a very successful local association. On the state level, he served as a Central Area Director for eight (8) years and served on many state committees. He introduced computing to the PSBA and was one of the pioneers in getting the tournament to be run on the computer.

On the lanes, Fred holds a high average of 187, a high single of 280 and high series of 660. He was the 1959 all events champion in the Altoona Penn Classic Tournament and has several local association championships to his credit. He was the first man inducted into the Seven Mountains Bowling Hall of Fame.
