TOURNAMENT OVERVIEW AND SCHEDULE

With the new 1:1 ratio, the electronic registration system and paper entries will close two weeks prior to District Start Date. Only walk in entries are permitted beyond that date at an additional fee. (District Level Only)

The U12, U15, and U18 Division Champions from the state finals will receive a berth from USBC into the 2022 Junior Gold Championships. **All advancers must be Junior Gold program members or be eligible and purchase a membership prior to the championships.**

Please remember: An athlete is not required to belong to the Junior Gold Program to bowl in the U12, U15 and U18 divisions. If an athlete does win the U12, U15, and U18 Division and he/she is not a Junior Gold Program member, he/she must purchase membership prior to the 2022 Junior Gold Championships to advance. If he/she is unwilling to purchase membership, the athlete keeps any awards given from the state/district but will not be allowed to advance to the Junior Gold Championships and an alternate will be chosen.

PA STATE USBC PEPSI YBC DISTRICT LEVEL RULES



1. The Pepsi USBC Youth Championships is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and governed by USBC rules.
2. Advancement ratio from the league to District competition is one (1) in one (1). Essentially all league bowlers bowling in a certified league in Pennsylvania are eligible.
3. District competition will take place at a designated center, time, and place to be determined by the District Tournament Director. Squad availability will be seen on the online registration system.
4. Entry deadline for all entries is two weeks prior to District Start Date (see District Schedule for Details). Electronic registration closes and all paper entries must be postmarked by that date. Walk-in entries will be accepted after this date only at an increased entry fee. Walk-ins must complete entry form and submit payment at least ½ hour before the start of each squad. Walk-in entries accepted based on lane availability.
5. Competition will be conducted in 10 divisions based on the participant's age as listed below. Participation in the wrong age division will lead to automatic disqualification.

6. **ENTRY FEES PER BOWLER:** (Online or submitted on paper)

Awards and scholarship fees shall be returned 100% to the bowlers. A **walk-in expense fee** of \$5 will be added to the entry fee per bowler who enters at the tournament site as a walk-in. (**Note:** The actual scholarship dollars awarded will equate to \$28.00/entrant, with 50% being awarded at the District Level and 50% at the State Level. These funds are derived from entry fees, interest, expired scholarships, and fund raisers.)

REFUNDS: Refunds will only be granted up to the advance closing date for entries, and will be paid after the closing date. Refunds after that date will be at the discretion of the state tournament director. **NO REFUNDS** for no shows at the event. The processing fee portion of the entry fee is not refundable under any circumstance. Refunds must be requested through the State Tournament director and must be in writing. Overpayments greater than \$5.00 will be refunded after entry closing date to the original payor.

7. All divisions shall bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes. Results will be determined by total pin fall in each division.
8. All bowlers must stay in the division they entered during all levels of competition. If a bowler enters out of league level in more than one state/district, the bowler must declare one state/district to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state/district will result in automatic disqualification.
9. **DRESS CODE:** All clothing may not have any holes or tears. All clothing shall cover all undergarments appropriately, no midriffs, low cut or revealing clothing is allowed. All t-shirts, collared shirts must have sleeves. Full length pants, capris, skirts, skorts and shorts are permissible. All skirts, skorts, or shorts must be no more than three inches above the knee. Tournament management will have the final say in determining if a competitor's clothing is acceptable for the tournament or not. No electronic devices may be worn during competition. **Penalty:** First offense will result in a verbal warning and apparel change or removal of equipment. Failure to comply will cause the bowler's scores to be disqualified and the bowler to be removed from the competition.
10. No substitutes will be permitted once athletes have started tournament play.

PA STATE USBC PEPSI YBC DISTRICT LEVEL RULES (CONT.)

11. Competitors shall be allowed up to 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes. District director will set limit and be consistent throughout event.
12. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero (0). Bowlers not present to bowl when it is his/her turn shall be credited with a zero for that frame.
13. All ties will receive a scholarship equal to the amount designated for that position.
14. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
15. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
16. Advancement ratio from the District level to the State level shall be at least one (1) for every five (5) entries or major fraction thereof. All ties for advancement shall advance.
17. Scholarships will be awarded for at least one (1) in eight (8) entries or major fraction thereof at the District Level. Scholarship amounts to be awarded will be determined by entries. All scholarships offered are managed by the USBC SMART fund, Account #8543.
18. State competition will take place in Limerick, PA on May 14-15, 2022 at Limerick Bowl, 653 W Ridge Pike, Limerick, PA 19468. Phone: 610/495-7143. (A 48-lane facility)
19. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Pennsylvania State Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Tournament Director. This Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Director reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

PA STATE USBC PEPSI YBC STATE LEVEL RULES

1. The Pepsi USBC Youth Championships is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and governed by USBC rules.
2. Advancement ratio from the previous competition (District) to State competition shall be at least one (1) for every five (5) entries or major fraction thereof. All ties for advancement shall advance.
3. If a bowler advances out of league level in more than one state/district, the bowler must declare one state/district to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state/district will result in automatic disqualification.
4. State competition will take place in Limerick, PA on May 14-15, 2022 at Limerick Bowl, 653 W Ridge Pike, Limerick, PA 19468. Phone: 610/495-7143. (A 48-lane facility)
5. Entry closing date is May 11, 2022. All bowlers will select their squad time and pay entry fees via on-line electronic registration via the State Associations Web Site. State finalists will receive instructions and information from the state tournament director by mail.
6. Competition will be conducted in 12 divisions based on the participant's age as listed below.

7. All divisions shall bowl three (3) games. Each game shall be rolled on a different pair. Results will be determined by total pin fall in each division.
8. **ENTRY FEES: None**
9. **DRESS CODE:** All clothing may not have any holes or tears. All clothing shall cover all undergarments appropriately, no midriffs, low cut or revealing clothing is allowed. All t-shirts, collared shirts must have sleeves. Full length pants, capris, skirts, skorts and shorts are permissible. All skirts, skorts, or shorts must be no more than three inches above the knee. Tournament management will have the final say in determining if a competitor's clothing is acceptable for the tournament or not. No electronic devices may be worn during competition. **Penalty:** First offense will result in a verbal warning and apparel change or removal of equipment. Failure to comply will cause the bowler's scores to be disqualified and the bowler to be removed from the competition.
10. No substitutions are permitted, however replacements may be used for bowlers not present 15 minutes prior to their scheduled squad time. **Replacements must be from order of finish from prior level of competition, Districts.**
11. If no replacement has been made, bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero (0). Bowlers not present to bowl when it is his/her turn shall be credited with a zero for that frame.
12. Competitors shall be allowed up to 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
13. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
14. Awards & Scholarships: Symbolic awards and Scholarships will be awarded for at least one (1) in every eight (8) entries of major fraction thereof per division. Total scholarship dollars offered based on participation. All scholarships offered are managed by the USBC SMART fund, Account #8543. Ties for scholarship positions, scholarship monies for affected positions will be combined and divided equally. Ties in the Divisions affecting Junior Gold finalists only, will be broken by a one game roll-off. Should a tie still exist, it will be broken with an additional 9th and 10th frame roll-off, until a winner is determined.
15. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
16. The first-place winners of the U12, U15 and U18 divisions for both Girls and Boys will advance to the 2022 Junior Gold Championships on July 9-17, 2022. They must be USBC Junior Gold members to advance to the Junior Gold Championships. Bowlers without a current Junior Gold membership must purchase a Junior Gold membership prior to June 8. IBC Youth will waive the \$200 (U18), \$150 (U15), and \$100 (U12) entry fee for these athletes. These athletes will compete for additional scholarships available to all athletes at the Junior Gold Championships, as well as other prizes and awards. All U.S. citizens are vying for a spot on USBC Junior Team USA 2022 to represent the United States in national and international competition. If the U12, U15 or U18 Division Champion is unwilling to become a Junior Gold member, they will not advance to the Junior Gold Championships. However, the athlete will still retain the state/zone scholarship, but the berth to the Junior Gold Championships will be awarded to the next eligible athlete. Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships, or, failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. Replacements will be selected based on the order of finish in their division at the state/zone level. Replacements will incur all costs associated with changing the airline ticket, if applicable. If the eligible advancer decides not to attend the Junior Gold Championships, any stipends offered will be forfeited. However, any scholarships earned at the state/zone level will be retained.
17. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Pennsylvania State Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Tournament Director. This Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Tournament Director reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

YOUTH HANDICAP SCHOLARSHIP SINGLES TOURNAMENT OVERVIEW AND SCHEDULE

The Pennsylvania Handicap Scholarship Singles Tournament is an open entry event. The dates, places and times coincide with the Pennsylvania State Pepsi Youth Bowling Championships Tournament. Bowlers may qualify and participate in both events if they so choose. These tournaments are separate events, one is scratch, the other handicap, with this handicap tournament not requiring qualification to bowl in Districts, bowlers can enter directly.



The new online registration system and paper entries will close **two weeks prior to the District Start Date**. All entries must be submitted by that date, no exceptions.

Qualifying competition is held in divisions based on the bowler's highest league average as indicated below:

1. The Pennsylvania Handicap Scholarship Singles Tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and governed by USBC rules.
2. **Eligibility:** Each entrant in the Annual tournament must be a certified league member of the USBC within the area served by the state association.
3. District competition will take place at a designated center, time, and place to be determined by the District Tournament Director. Squad availability will be seen on the online registration system.
4. Entry deadline for all entries is two weeks prior to District Start Date (see District Schedule for Details). Electronic registration closes and all paper entries must be postmarked by that date. Walk-in entries will be accepted after this date only at an increased entry fee. Walk-ins must complete entry form and submit payment at least ½ hour before the start of each squad. Walk-in entries accepted based on lane availability.
5. **Bowlers shall use their highest current certified league average (Standard Ten Pin Only) as of January 1, 2022**, minimum of nine (9) games. Averages must be verified by a league standing sheet. If a bowler does not have a minimum of 9 games as of Jan. 1, 2022, average at the time of bowling in the District Tournament, shall be used, providing 9 games have been bowled, if not, the bowler will bowl scratch (no handicap) in the 151 and above division. Bowlers with Challenge/Sport League averages shall adjust their average as per Rule 202d of the USBC Rules Book. Competition will be conducted in 6 divisions based on the participant's average as listed below.

7. All divisions shall bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes. Results will be determined by total pin fall plus handicap in each division.
8. Multiple participation is not permitted, bowlers may enter and bowl only once. If a bowler bowls in a second district, the bowler shall be disqualified, and entry fees will not be returned.
9. Handicap shall be 100% of the difference between bowler's average and 220 for Division A, 150 for Division B and 110 for Division C. Anyone above the average base will receive 100% negative handicap.
10. **DRESS CODE:** All clothing may not have any holes or tears. All clothing shall cover all undergarments appropriately, no midriffs, low cut or revealing clothing is allowed. All t-shirts, collared shirts must have sleeves. Full length pants, capris, skirts, skorts and shorts are permissible. All skirts, skorts, or shorts must be no more than three inches above the knee. 11. No substitutes will be permitted once athletes have started tournament play.
12. Competitors shall be allowed up to 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes. District director will set limit and be consistent throughout event.
13. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero (0). Bowlers not present to bowl when it is his/her turn shall be credited with a zero for that frame.
14. All ties will receive a scholarship equal to the amount designated for that position.
15. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
16. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
17. Advancement ratio from the District level to the State level shall be at least one (1) for every five (5) entries or major fraction thereof. All ties for advancement shall advance.
18. Scholarships will be awarded for at least one (1) in eight (8) entries or major fraction thereof at the District Level. Scholarship amounts to be awarded will be determined by entries. All scholarships offered are managed by the USBC SMART fund, Account # 11455 and #8543.

YOUTH HDCP SCHOLARSHIP SINGLES STATE LEVEL RULES

1. The Pennsylvania Handicap Scholarship Singles Tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and governed by USBC rules.
2. Advancement ratio from the previous competition (District) to State competition shall be at least one (1) for every five (5) entries or major fraction thereof. All ties for advancement shall advance.
3. State competition will take place in Limerick, PA on May 14-15, 2022 at Limerick Bowl, 653 W Ridge Pike, Limerick, PA 19468. Phone: 610/495-7143. (A 48-lane facility)
4. Entry closing date is May 11, 2022. All bowlers will select their squad time and pay entry fees via on-line electronic registration via the State Associations Web Site. State finalists will receive instructions and information from the state tournament director by mail.
5. **Bowlers shall use their highest current certified league average (Standard Ten Pin Only) as of January 1, 2022**, minimum of nine (9) games. Averages must be verified by a league standing sheet. If a bowler does not have a minimum of 9 games as of Jan. 1, 2022, average at the time of bowling in the District Tournament, shall be used, providing 9 games have been bowled, if not, the bowler will bowl scratch (no handicap). Bowlers with Sport League averages shall adjust their average as per Rule 202d of the USBC Rules Book. Competition will be conducted in 6 divisions based on the participant's age as listed below.

6. Handicap shall be 100% of the difference between bowler's average and 220 for Division A, 150 for Division B and 110 for Division C. Anyone above the average base will receive 100% negative handicap.

9. **DRESS CODE:** All clothing may not have any holes or tears. All clothing shall cover all undergarments appropriately, no midriffs, low cut or revealing clothing is allowed. 11. If no replacement has been made, bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed shall be credited with a zero (0). Bowlers not present to bowl when it is his/her turn shall be credited with a zero for that frame.
12. Competitors shall be allowed up to 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
13. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.
14. Awards & Scholarships: Symbolic awards and Scholarships will be awarded for at least one (1) in every eight (8) entries of major fraction thereof per division. Total scholarship dollars offered based on participation. All scholarships offered are managed by the USBC SMART fund, Account #11455 & #8543. Ties for scholarship positions, scholarship monies for affected positions will be combined and divided equally.
15. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the Tournament Director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the Tournament Director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
